3D SCULPTURAL FORMS WORKSHOP MAY 11TH

Imagine a world of weird and wonderful 3D shapes, coiled and twisted, hanging and free standing, organic and geometric? This is an opportunity for some concentrated, playful exploration of the 3rd dimension. We will be inspired by images, play with building blocks, do origami, cut and glue. And, if there is any time left we will do some simple hand stitching.

REQUIREMENTS

Paper scissors

Cellotape

Glue stick

Protractor (one of those half moon plastic thingumys we used in geometry at school)

Pins

Bone folder or similar

Magazine or newspaper which can be torn up

Ruler

Pencil

Notebook

Device for photographing your creations, eg. Camera, iPad, smartphone

Fabric which can be torn into strips – about 15cms

Contrasting yarn

Strong thread for stitching in toning colour, such as crochet cotton, perle, quilting thread or similar

Hand sewing needle to suit your thread

Sharp scissors

Couple of small bulldog clips

Optional

Steel ruler

Stanley knife

Cutting board

Please bring along a 3D textile piece that you have made and particularly like if you have one.

When you arrive can you set the tables up in 'u' shape, facing the front, please?
