84 Group Polymer Clay Workshop - Sunday 8th March with Pam Annesley



<u>Workshop:</u> An exploration of colour and texture to make an individual brooch, pendant or earrings.

Techniques:

Conditioning polymer clay, blending colours, make a bullseye cane, using and making texture with simple tools, make extruded strands of clay sharing an extruder tool. Explore shape to form a pendant and earrings. Make a bail and holes for earring hooks.

Materials provided \$10 Polymer Clay (Additional clay may be purchased @ \$5 per block) plus one brooch back or bail or pair earring hooks. (Additional findings may be purchased)

What to Bring:

Work surface: Gladbake paper, plastic A4 envelope, take away container to carry any unbaked clay home

Razorblade or craft knife

Tooth picks and darning needle (for making holes and texture)

Open weave cloth (muslin), lace, etc for texture

Metal knitting needle for smoothing

Plastic roller (if you have one. I will bring some)

Pasta machine if you have one. I will have some to share in groups.
