An exploration of fabric manipulation, specifically polyester fabric using a combination of stitch, microwave and stove. The addition of some dye process will excite and enliven the finished product.

Ideas for further embellishment and use of techniques in your own work should abound.

REQUIREMENTS

- 1mtr white nylon organza [curtaining?]
- .5mtr x 4 different polyester based fabrics – Poly cotton; Satin; Chiffon; Crepe.
- All preferably white or light colour as we will also be doing some dyeing
- Plastic bags and a bucket to take wet fabrics home.
- Black plastic to cover tables, and the floor if you are a messy worker.
- Hand towel and large towel for mopping up any mess.
- Scissors
- Pins
- Ice cream containers
- Sewing machine
- Hand needles
- Quilting thread – for hand sewing with strength that will not break easily as you pull up fabrics.
- String -White Kitchen string.
- Iron and mini ironing board will be advantageous if you have them.

I will be providing many extra materials and dyes as needed.
